- Safeguarding Policy
- The Executive Committee of Welshpool Community Transport has recognised the importance of safeguarding and DBS checks in the minutes of a committee meeting.
- This Policy formalises that previous decision.
- The Policy covers volunteer drivers who use their own cars to transport adults who are the recipients of taxi tokens provided by Welshpool Community Transport.
- An adult at risk is defined as an adult with care and support needs who is at risk of or suffering harm abuse or neglect and who due to their care and support needs are unable to protect themselves.
- Volunteer drivers are entrusted with the responsibility to detect/ prevent any incident which could be regarded as harm/abuse and to report any such incident to the Chairman of the Charity.
- In support of the above the Executive Committee requires volunteer drivers to participate in an enhanced DBS check. Drivers are also asked to check that their car insurance covers their voluntary activities.
